

Trademark, Copyright and Protected Items

Go and reread your membership agreement if you need to...because we want to make sure you are the original artist (copyright holder) for all the great photographic art you send us. Sending us any of the following is considered dodgy and might get you in a lot of strife and result in us banning you or taking nasty legal action (so be good):

- A photograph of a photograph (really bad).
- A photograph that you didn't take (very naughty).
- An image you've copied e.g. from a book, the web or another publication (seriously not good).
- Images from other stock photography agencies (plain dumb).

Here at lensartis we take all this stuff very seriously, we will decline any art works that contain the following:

- Logos, trademarks, company names, product names, product brands or trademarked and patented design.
- **Patented & Trademarked Product Designs:** most modern toys, many brand name watches, brand name computers and other licensed products.
- **Artwork:** Paintings, sculptures, any object in a museum, any object in an art gallery, including

public sculpture, some architecture, advertisements, other photography (a photo of a photo).

- **Documents:** Modern maps, documents where names are mentioned, computer screens (interfaces and icons are copyrighted).
- **Government & Military Property:** scans of currency, military decorations.
- **Trademarked Buildings, Monuments & Landmarks:** Due to this being a grey area (i.e. intellectual property laws) it's best to research the structure or landmark before submitting the image to lensartist.
